 - Selectman requested Road Agent to reduce solid waste...Burns solicited bids...Corcoran Recycling teamed up with Pinard Waste and had lowest bid...every address gets a cart (64 gal)...\$400k investment for the contractor...contract written for Hudson to pay lump sum for trash...goal is to reduce solid waste by increasing recycling...stickers to be issued to educate public...Luszey requested that the totes be delivered to people who want them...carts to be delivered to homes beginning 6/15/07...

 - Emphasis of the board will be "education and increase of recycled trash"
